July 11, Service at Mt. St. Francis, then ending the day with a cookout and fun there at the Mount. I will still need a few volunteers to help transport youth and be chaperones. Also, I am asking for high school youth to help be the prayer and activity leaders. I have sent letter and forms home to parents, as well as in emails.

We have a great size group of teens attending the **Wolfe Pack Mission** trip this year: Sarah Easton, Luke Malone, Mandy Ellis, and Josey Waterbury. They will be on the trip June 13-17. The youth paid their first \$100, then the remaining amount came from the money they had earned from fundraising efforts. Total amount of the trip is \$350 per youth.

It is for high school youth and stye stay each night at Mt. St. Francis, then go into community during the day. I am trying to get a few youth (mainly incoming freshman - juniors) to attend. Cost is \$245.
