It was one of my favorite opportunities with youth. They not only helped people with their homes, but they made god relationships with residents and built on their own faith.

We had one teenage youth, Wyatt Romines, attend Faith In Action, a local Mission experience of service in the community and then social and spiritual retreat at Mt. St. Francis in the evenings. I checked in on Wyatt one morning when I helped serve breakfast to the crew. Around 18 teens from the deanery participated. He seemed to be having a great time and really opening up after the first few days. I was super happy, since this was his first big youth ministry experience.

She was put into the Usher and Greeter Ministry, and I attended Youth Minister sessions. We also attended reconciliation service, a Marian Tour, daily Mass, Liturgy of the Hours, and much more! Summer Daze has also come and gone! We had around 8 middle school youth attend, with Josey and Ashlyn Waterbury helping out as high school leaders. We joined with Starlight for a combined 13 youth. We helped serve at the Franciscan Kitchen, St. Mary of the Knobs school, and Mt. St. Francis-youth ministry office. Our socials were at Atlantis Wat park, Mt. St. Francis deanery picnic and games, and then also did an art project at OLPH after Opening Mass. There were probably around 100 middle schoolers from the deanery in attendance.

Now, I am working on registrations and information needed for NCYC. We have around 21 high school youth attending from both Navilleton and Starlight, and will go as one group. The dates are Nov. 16-19 in Indianapolis again this year! I am also starting to coordinate fall and winter events, since the youth are all starting school next week! EEK!!!
